NOTES RE "DIGEST" OF TASMANIAN SUPREME COURT CASES

- 1) The list includes cases from 1840-1857 (inclusive).
- 2) All cases are taken from the "colonial times" up until the end of 1853 unless otherwise stated in the "Digest" (in the beginning I marked a lot of them "C.T." but later on no newspaper reference has been given).
- 3) However cases from January-June 30th 1854 have been taken from the "HOBART TOWN DAILY COURIER" (H.T.D.C.).
Then from July-December 1854 the cases come from the "Mercury".
All cases from this year should be marked with either (H.T.D.C.) or ("Merc.") depending on which paper the report was taken from.
- 4) From January 1855 - December 1857 all cases were taken from the Mercury.
- 5) There are some cards with a number of cases on them ranging from 1856-1896 (taken from the "thin grey book in the Law Library"). I have not put them on the end of the lists because Sharon found in Hobart that these were not the only cases - only a select few.
- 6) I have made an index of all the subject headings which is at the front of all the papers and the papers have all been filed in alphabetical order.
