

Extract from Order by Lt. Col. B. 1806  
14 October 1804 to 8 Jan<sup>y</sup> 1806

The natives having solicited to return to Sydney and Parramatta no molestation is to be offered to those frequenting the above places provided they behave quietly, otherwise they are to be reported to the Magistrate who will order them to be expelled - The natives about Newcastle and George Town still continue their depredations the General Order of the 27<sup>th</sup> of April is to continue in force respecting these places, and it is hoped the apprehension of the natives' evil Musquito might effectually prevent any further mischief in these quarters.
